### Shopping Trips – Book from Friday 20<sup>th</sup> November

#### IMPORTANT NOTICE

Following the November lockdown, we have planned for a limited service in December. There will be two trips to Henley Tesco and one trip to Waitrose each week. We will also be running two trips to Reading Morrisons and one to Reading Town Centre. To conform to the current guidelines, we will carry a maximum of five passengers on each trip. However, there may be trip cancellations depending upon driver availability.

**Please note that any change to the government's guidelines on Covid-19, either nationally or locally, may result in changes to or the suspension of the planned timetable.**

#### Please Note

If you decide to travel, then please understand that you do so at your own risk although we will take every precaution to ensure the bus is cleaned appropriately after each journey. If you have a serious underlying health condition, you should consider having your shopping delivered by FISH instead of making a booking. The driver will provide the usual assistance with carrying shopping bags to your front door.

#### You must not travel:

If you, or anyone in your household, has a cough, a high temperature, any shortness of breath, a loss of taste or smell or are just feeling generally unwell.

#### If you decide to travel, you must:

- Be able to get on the bus unaided and be able to fit the seatbelt yourself.
- Wear a face mask or covering at all times unless medically exempt
- Use the hand sanitiser provided each time you get on the bus, even if you are wearing gloves.
- Follow the driver's guidance on where to sit and when to get on and off the bus.
- Try to keep as much distance as possible from others at all times.
