Take a journey through more than 100 years of Oxford's car building history and discover how BMW creates over 1,000 one-of-a-kind, made-to-order MINIs every day.

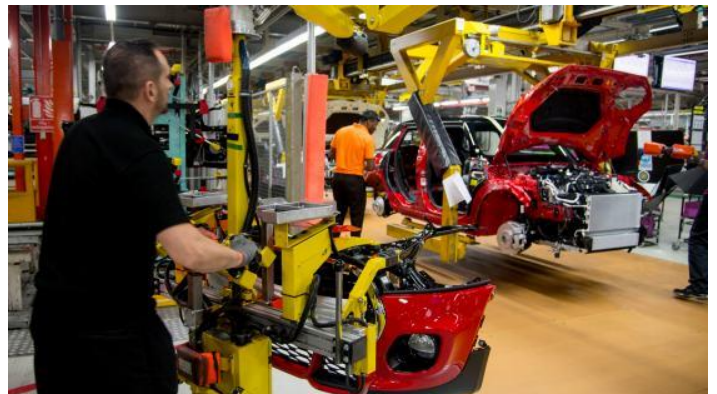
Visit MINI's production halls where human skill and state-of-the-art technology combine to build a new MINI every 67 seconds.
